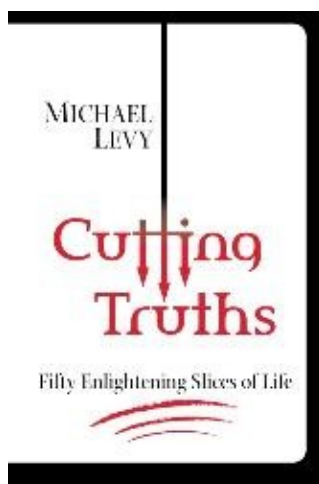


Cutting Truths
